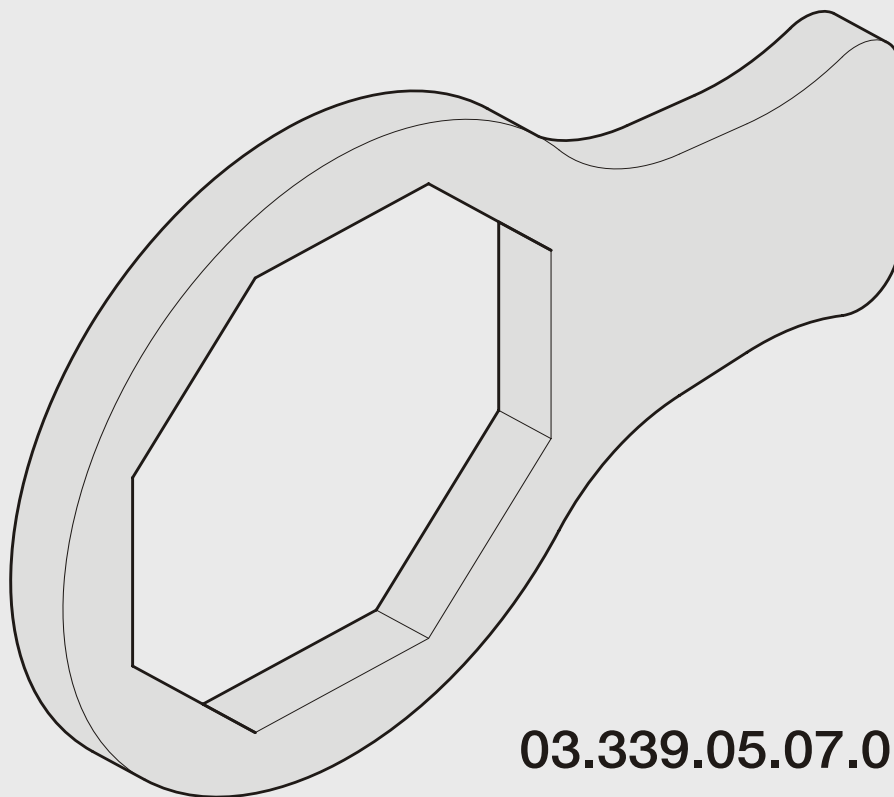

## Conversion of hub cap spanner

With the launch of the ECO Plus 2, there have been changes to the code numbers for versions 03.339.05.02.0 and 03.339.05.07.0!

The spanner 03.339.05.07.0 (formerly BPW shape, size 120) now has the shape of the 03.339.05.02.0 version (octagonal, size 120)

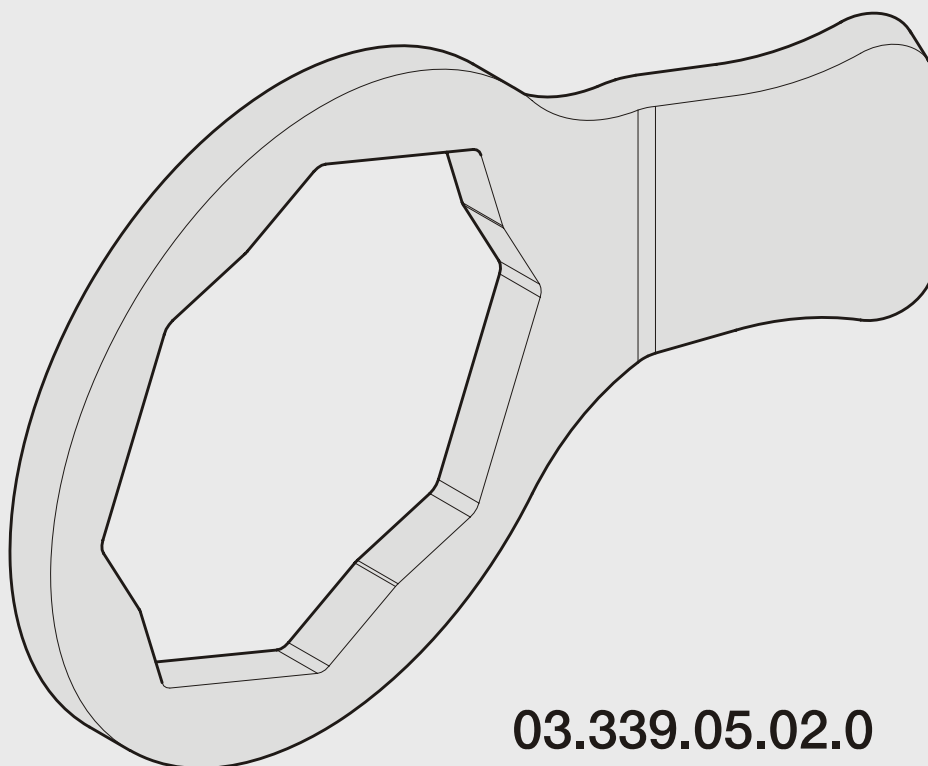

The spanner 03.339.05.02.0 (formerly octagonal, size 120) now has a revised shape of the 03.339.05.07.0 version which means it can be used for ECO Plus 2 with 120 / 0 offset.

Our new brake shoes, brake shoes sets and lining sets will be supplied with the new lining spanner that facilitates installation.

The previous brake lining (WVA 19032) is not suitable for the new generation of brake shoes!
