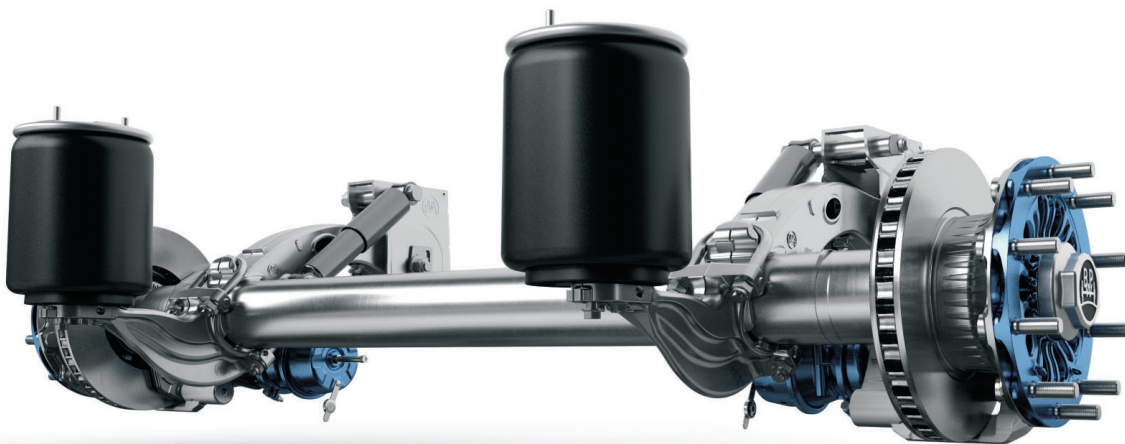

Series launch of the new ECO Air

From May 2019, the new BPW ECO Air air suspension will be introduced with the new disc brake ECO Disc TS2 and the well-known drum brake ECO Drum.



BPW ECO Air is the new running gear generation from BPW. It is lighter, more versatile, more efficient and digital and has been new designed from the ground up.

The two well-known versions „ECO Air Compact“ and „ECO Air Compact HD“ will be replaced by the new „ECO Air“.

The series launch with the new disc brake BPW ECO Disc TS2 and the well-known drum brake ECO Drum will take place from May 2019.

This results in the following timetable:

From February 2019:

BPW will provide conversion lists (old ECO Air Compact/ ECO Air Compact HD and correspondingly new ECO Air versions) to ensure a smooth conversion. These changeover lists will be sent to you within the next few days.

From March 2019:

New and already existing orders with ECO Air Compact/ ECO Air Compact HD with the order confirmation date from week 19/2019 on will be entered or transferred in the new ECO Air version after consultation with the customer.



From May 2019:

Over a period of 6 weeks, all customers will be converted step by step to 100% ECO Air. We will inform you about the exact conversion date in good time. You will also be informed about the conversion of your orders in the order confirmation.

After the conversion, delivery will only take place with the new air suspension ECO Air.
